Activities like playing cards, journals, coloring books, crayons, stickers, etc

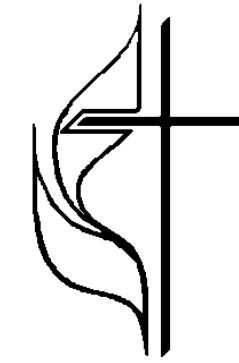
