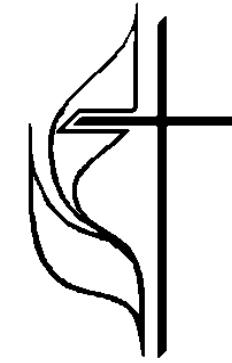
- **Utah / Western Colorado District Gathering**
