Ukraine Assistance

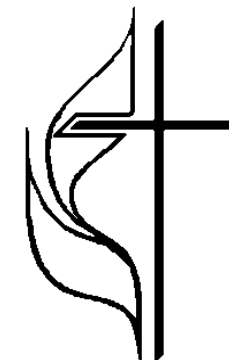
