Memorial Window Information

The Sanctuary of Christ UMC is being renovated piece by piece, and to start we are working on the stained glass windows. Ever a work in progress, we are looking for individuals, families and/or groups who would like to donate a window to be installed in our beautiful sanctuary, bringing light and story to our timeless building. Each window will be accompanied by a plaque in memoriam.

A decade ago, a "Windows Committee" was formed to consider replacing the original windows installed by the builders of our sanctuary in the 1950's. The Committee had two aims: one, to increase the light entering the sanctuary, and to honor loved ones for whom donations are held in trust with the Memorials Committee. A design representing the Wasatch Front mountains visible from our church building was submitted. It includes the re-use of stained glass from the original triangles of red, blue, and green in a border around each panel.

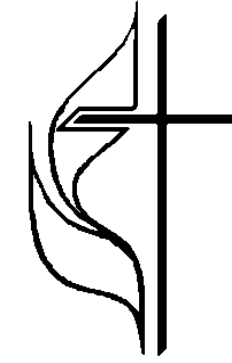
