



This could be a one time donation or if you would like to make a lasting impact you can make a donation in the form of setting up a monthly recurring donation of \$14 a month via the Friends of Pando Donate Page (friendsofpando.org/donate), which can pay for one day of fieldwork to study and protect the tree.

<u>VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY AT PANDO</u> - Friends of Pando is also organizing a work week in the tree in late August, so those who want to get their hands dirty helping remove juniper and clearing the forest floor are encouraged to sign up via Friends of Pando's volunteer page (friendsofpando.org/volunteer).

WRITE – Utah's Executive Director of the Department of Natural Resources, Joel Ferry, was recently appointed to the board of the Utah Inland Port Authority. As a new board member, public servant and a steward of Utah's precious natural resources, it's time to make the public's concerns extremely clear to him. SIGN OR SEND LETTERS TO YOUR LEGISLATORS - The proposed Weber County Inland Port will harm over 8000 acres of wetlands. Use the link <a href="https://www.stopthepollutingport.org">https://www.stopthepollutingport.org</a> to sign the petition, send letters to your legislators, or call the Utah Inland Port Authority Board to say NO to the Weber County Inland Port, as well as other Inland Port proposals.
